	mm margins on all sides.
	Original papers, clinical papers, and review articles: within 8,000 words, case reports and research bulletins
	within 6,000 words, short reports: within 5,000 words.
	Each submission should include three to four keywords at the end of the abstract.
	The abbreviation (running title) of 20 characters or less is described.
	The format of the paper should be in the following order: introduction, research methods (subject), results,
	discussion, conclusion, acknowledgments (if necessary), and references.
	References are in order of citation in the prescribed manner of description according to the submission rules.
	Photographs should be approximately 83 × 108-mm paper size, and figures and tables, etc., should be sent for
	immediate printing.
	Insertion points for figures and tables are written in red in the text.
	The manuscript should be arranged in the following order: cover, abstract, keywords, text, references, figure
	legends, figures (photographs), and tables.
	For content involving human subjects, the World Medical Association's Declaration of Helsinki and the Min-
	istry of Health, Labour and Welfare's guidelines for scientific research must be observed. Moreover, it must
	be clearly stated that "approval has been obtained from the ethics committee" of the author's institution.
	For content involving animals, it must be clearly stated that "approval has been obtained from the animal
	experiment committee" of the author's institution.
	In accordance with the guidelines and detailed regulations on conflict of interest (COI), COI information for
	all authors of the paper has been submitted and is listed at the end of the text.
	The author and co-authors are members of the Society for the Temporomandibular Joint if the authors be-
	longing to the Japanese institutions.
	Manuscripts are checked by the head of the institution.
	Received guidance on statistics in the paper from a statistics instructor.
	The patient's written consent is obtained for the use of identifiable photographs, imaging data, or genetic
	codes of the subjective patients, and that is described in the text.
	The manuscript should be checked by professional translators if the authors are not English speakers.
